Exposure Draft 02/24 Proposed Standard: APES 220 Taxation Services

CPA Australia supports the proposed amendments to APES 220 Taxation Service. We welcome the alignment of APES 220 Taxation Services with recent revisions to APES 110 Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (including Independence Standards).

The proposed changes to paragraph 3.12, which enable Members to determine the appropriateness of informing the Client, Employer or relevant third party of a legal, regulatory or professional duty or right to disclose, with which they have complied, are particularly welcome.

Additionally, the clarification in paragraph 5.3 that Members are not precluded from assisting their Client or Employer to remediate or rectify a tax planning arrangement that lacks a credible basis, or from providing other Taxation Services to the Client or Employer, is welcomed.
